With the United Kingdom transitioning out of the **European Union on December 31 2020**, we have ensured that our services and influence to our clients will not be impacted by any changes that have been put in place. If you are an existing client, you do not need to take any action with us now or after Brexit to ensuring that our services remain operational.

We understand that in certain circumstances it can be difficult to understand the current situation around Brexit and what will happen.

### **Will there be any Changes to Gravitai Services after Brexit?**

No there will not be any changes to our services and will continue to operate as normal if you are existing customer or potential one looking for more information. You do not need to take any action with us during the Brexit period or after. Everything will resume as normal.

### **How will Data be Affected now the United Kingdom has left the EU?**

Gravitai's data processing practises will not affect how we operate in collation with you as a client. Our agreement and privacy policy ensures that all our customers, users and clients are covered and such personal data can continue to flow both through the United Kingdom and also Europe.

*As of now an interim of six months has been allocated for unrestricted data flow between the two blocs that being the United Kingdom and the EU. This is expected to end in June 2021 with an adequacy decision being reached before the period has ended. Please continue to stay up to date with our Brexit GDPR stance as new information comes to light.*

To align with the new laws set in place, that being **UK-GDPR** and the updated version of **Data Protection Act**, Gravitai aligns with the new privacy laws that have been set our regrading personal data.
